INTRODUCTION

The Christian Medical College Ludhiana is a Christian Educational and Research Institution established, maintained, and administered by the Christian Medical College Ludhiana Society (regd.) of Christian Churches and Christian agencies.

The Medical Missionary work was started in Ludhiana in the year 1881 by Miss Martha Rose and Miss Kay Greenfield popularly known as the Greenfield sisters. They were Evangelists and Educationalists from Scotland. This pioneering medical work of the Greenfield sisters was the precursor of the Medical Training and Health Care Service Program of the present Christian Medical College, Ludhiana.

The Greenfield sisters and their associates organized the Health Care Educational Services in which endeavor Dr. Edith Mary Brown joined them in 1893. In 1894 the North Indian School of Medicine for Christian Women was started by Dr. Edith Mary Brown and her colleagues with the objective of training Indian women, to serve in the field of Medical Education and Health Care Services, emphasizing integration of training and health care services.

The period from 1894 to 1952 was an epoch-making era which saw the development of Women's Christian Medical School from its beginning as a School of Medicine for Christian Women. The Medical School granted LSMF (Licentiate of State Medical Faculty) Diploma till 1952. In 1953 LSMF was upgraded to the MBBS course, and the name of the Institution was changed to Christian Medical College to enable it to admit both men and women students. Postgraduate program started in the next decade.

Punjab, the land of five rivers, is known for its rich heritage and culture. A land of hard-working people it has earned the term of breadbasket of India due to its great agricultural strengths. Ludhiana is one of the oldest-established cities of Punjab with a population that has increased during recent years to around 25,00,000 lies 312 km Northwest of Delhi and less than 150 km from the border with Pakistan. It is situated on the Grand Trunk Road running from the border through to Delhi and is an important railway junction. Today it is one of the fastest-growing small and medium industrial centers in India. Ludhiana is well connected to rest of India by train and road. The nearest airports are in Ludhiana, Amritsar, and Chandigarh.

The institution is situated in a large campus couple of kilometers from Ludhiana Railway Station, on both sides of the Brown Road named after Dame Edith M Brown. The Campus has residential quarters for the staff, hostels for medical, dental, nursing, and paramedical students, both men and women.

The various courses offered in CMC are affiliated to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot and other professional councils as may be applicable. The Christian Medical College offers Degree, Postgraduate Diploma, Postgraduate Degrees, Super-specialty Degrees and Doctoral courses. The Christian Medical College, Ludhiana is a recognized institution by Medical Council of India. **Each year 100 students, men and women, are admitted to the MBBS course.** Nursing training was started in 1889 by the Greenfield Sisters. The Nursing School became well – known for the nursing care it provided and for its services to needy patients. The General Nursing Program was established in 1936 and regular program was started in 1941. Each year 50 students are admitted to the General Nursing & Midwifery Diploma Program. The School of Nursing was upgraded to College of Nursing in 1973 with 18 students admitted to the B.Sc. Nursing course. Each year 60 students are admitted to the B.Sc. Nursing Degree Program. The M.Sc. Nursing program started in 1987 with two specialties (Psychiatric nursing & Maternal and Child Health Nursing). At present five M.Sc. Nursing course specialties are available (Psychiatric Nursing, Obstetric Nursing, Pediatric Nursing, Medical & Surgical Nursing and Community Health Nursing). The M.Sc. Nursing Post Graduate Degree Program offers five specialties with an intake of 5 seats in each, totaling 25 seats.

Since the Nursing standard is maintained at a high level, the results of our examinations have always been excellent. In response to changing society nursing practice has changed from mere apprenticeship to a professional education and to foster nursing as a professional career, attractive and desirable to young people on an equal basis with any other career.

The Dental Department has been providing dental health care services in the hospital and the community at large since 1968. Besides providing high quality tertiary care in the hospital, the dental department launched its unique community dental health services in 1984 to rural areas reaching out primarily to the vulnerable population of the children which is one of few innovative community dental health services in India. The Christian Dental College was established in 1992 as the most prestigious off shoot of Christian Medical College Ludhiana.

The Christian Dental College, Ludhiana, admitted the pioneer batch to the BDS Course in August 1992, who graduated in 1996. The M.D.S. Course started in the year 2002. Each year 40 students are admitted to the BDS Course.

The College of Physiotherapy has been established in 2006. The physiotherapy department, a pioneer in this field in North India, has been training professionals for many years and now a formal bachelor's course has been approved by the University to **admit 20 students per annum starting from 2006.**

The Brown Memorial Hospital now known as CMC Hospital has 720 beds with the latest technology and the most competent doctors serving a wide array of population of North India.

Apart from the main undergraduate courses there are Post graduate degree, diploma, and super specialty courses in almost all the fields. There are also various training and diploma courses in Laboratory and allied health fields. The respective Principals may be contacted for details.

Our Faculty, Medical and Para-medical; teaching staff and other staff come from nearly every state in India. Staff of all faiths live and serve together in the Institution in an atmosphere of mutual respect, trust and love. The Government of India and Punjab have continued their interest and support in the work and the development of the college and its hospital.

ADMISSION - M.Sc. NURSING SESSION 2025 - 2026

Admission to the M.Sc. Nursing Programme of this college is made according to the rules and regulations of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, Punjab, Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and of the Government as may be applicable to this college. These are subject to alterations, amendments and modifications as may be necessary from time to time by the authority concerned. All admissions are subject to the approval of the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences.

COURSE OF STUDY and ALLOCATION OF SEATS

The following courses for the degree of Master of Science in Nursing are offered at the college of Nursing of the Christian Medical College Ludhiana Society, a Christian Minority institution. The Post graduate seats for M.Sc. Nursing are distributed as per the following categories; Category 1 - Open Category and Category 2 - Candidates with Service Commitment; 2A - Service Candidates; 2B - Christian Minority Candidates.

Duration of each course is two years. The course commences as per the Academic Calendar of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

NUMBER OF SEATS

There are 25 seats for men and women. Foreign Nationals may apply but application must be through Govt. of India as per rules.

Any seats falling vacant in category 2A will be filled from 2B and vice versa then from Category 1. Any seats vacant in Category 1 will be filled first from 2A then 2B. All admissions are made on merit secured in the Admission Test and additional marks if any.

CHRISTIAN MINORITY CANDIDATES:

Christian Minority candidates required to submit photocopies of the following certificates along with the application to be considered in this category:

- i) Baptism Certificate
- ii) Confirmation Certificate (if applicable)
- iii) Letter from the Pastor regarding Church Membership, with date and denomination of the Church with address.(in the prescribed format-Annexure-I)

Christian Medical College, Ludhiana was started with the objective of training young men and women to serve the poor and unreached sections of the society with the love and compassion of Jesus Christ. This mandate is fulfilled by our graduates in various hospitals of the members of the Christian Medical College Ludhiana Society situated all over India.

The original certificates must be available at the time of Counseling / Scrutiny of original certificates.

Uncompleted Service Obligation: The primary aim of the Christian Medical College, Ludhiana is to make a significant contribution to the health standards of all communities of our nation with a special emphasis on health care in the rural underserved and unreached areas/communities in India. This mandate is fulfilled by graduates who fulfill their sponsorship obligation by serving in such areas, participating and understanding the needs of the society. Non-fulfillment of service obligation for any reason violates the spirit of sponsorship.

REQUIREMENTS

ACADEMIC

In order to be eligible to apply for admission to the M.Sc. Nursing course of this college, an applicant must have passed one of the following examinations obtaining at least 55% marks in the aggregate.

a) Post-Basic B.Sc. Nursing examination of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot / Panjab University, Chandigarh.

OR

 b) B.Sc. Nursing examination of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot / Panjab University, Chandigarh.

OR

- c) Any other B.Sc. Nursing examination recognized by the Syndicate of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences as equivalent to (a) or (b) above. An applicant shall apply to the Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Kotkapura Road, Faridkot-151 203, Punjab for an eligibility certificate, if applicable.
- d) Post Basic B.Sc.(IGNOU) only from Centers recognized by the Indian Nursing Council (INC)

HEALTH :

If selected and found medically unfit by Staff & Student Health Services, Christian Medical College, Ludhiana, the candidate will not be allowed to continue the course.

REGISTRATION :

Must be a Registered Nurse & Registered Midwife recognized by Nursing Council of India. A Candidate who is not a Registered Midwife must have a short course certificate recognized by INC.

EXPERIENCE :

<u>Minimum one year work experience in Bed side Nursing / Public Health Nursing / Teaching</u> <u>after declaration of Final result of B.Sc. Nursing or prior to or after Post Basic B.Sc.</u> <u>Nursing before</u> date of Counseling.

NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE :

If a candidate is currently employed, a No Objection Certificate from the employer will be required.

PHOTOGRAPHS

Each applicant must provide four copies each of his/her recent passport size and stamp size photographs, taken in a photo-studio, which must clearly show full face, head and shoulder only.

- i) One photograph should be pasted on the Application Form.
- ii) Two photographs should have the applicant's name written clearly in English on the back of each photograph to be attached to the form.

 - i) Registered Nurse and
 - ii) Registered Midwife or short Course Certificate in lieu of Midwifery
- 10. Recent Domicile certificate
- 11. No Objection Certificate from the Employer (if applicable).
- 12. For Christian Minority Candidates: (A) Baptism Certificate, (B) Confirmation Certificate (if applicable) and (C) letter from the Pastor about Church membership and denomination of Church with address.

Proof of Posting will not be accepted as proof of delivery or receipt. No alterations can be made to any of the information provided on the application form once it has been submitted. If the application is submitted to the Registrar's Office by hand or courier service, a receipt should be obtained from the office of the Registrar.

ADMISSION TEST

This will consist of:

a) Written Test: Objective type and Multiple-choice Questions based on B.Sc. Nursing Syllabus prescribed by Indian Nursing Council for maximum of 180 marks.

The test will be held in College of Nursing, Christian Medical College, Ludhiana on 26.06.2025.

- The selection shall be strictly as per merit based upon the entrance examination.
- The candidate should have secured at least 35% in the Entrance Test.

The merit list will be on the total marks of 200 including the additional marks as given below.

ADDITIONAL MARKS

- 1) College of Nursing, CMC Ludhiana Graduates (B.Sc.(N)/GNM with Post Basic) will be given 10 additional marks.
- 2) College of Nursing, CMC Ludhiana Graduates (B.Sc.(N)/GNM with Post Basic) who have satisfactorily completed minimum of 2 years of service obligation or served in CMC Hospital or a member body of CMC Ludhiana Society without service obligation, will get 10 marks. OR

Staff Nurses working in a Government Hospital located in a Rural Area, for a minimum period of 2 years will get 10 marks

AT THE EXAMINATION CENTRE

At the examination center, the applicant must present his/her Hall Ticket bearing the application number and passport size photograph rubber stamped by the Registrar, Christian Medical College, Ludhiana.

The applicant must take his/her allotted seat in the Examination Room at the time given in the Admit Card otherwise the applicant may not be allowed to take the examination.

Please note that the applicants appearing for the Admission Written Test have to bear their travelling expenses and make their own arrangements for accommodation.

DECLARATION OF MERIT LIST

Provisional Merit list will be put on the Notice Board of the Registrar's Office, Christian Medical College, Ludhiana on or before 30.06.2025.

Tie Break : In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the complete entrance examination, their inter-se-merit will be determined in order of preference as under :

- i) Written Test marks out of 180
- ii) Age of the candidate in favour of the older candidate

COUNSELING/SCRUTINY OF ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES AND TESTIMONIALS AND SUBMISSION OF FEES

All merit listed candidates desirous of taking admissions should report to the Registrar's Office in person with original certificates and testimonials the date notified by registrar office. No separate information or call letter in this regard will be communicated other than publishing the merit list in the Registrar's Office Notice board/ website (www.cmcludhiana.in). Candidates will be called according to category and merit acquired in Admission Test and allotted seats in the various aforementioned courses. All Merit listed applicants must bring all relevant original certificates and testimonials and be present at the time of scrutiny. Any seat falling vacant in either category will be filled from the other category. All admissions are made on merit secured in the Admission Test.

Following scrutiny of certificates and testimonials, the selected applicants must submit the following to the Registrar in order to claim the seat as per schedule below:

- a) College fees and other fees (as applicable)
- b) Original Certificates etc.

If the seat is not claimed when offered as above, the offer shall be withdrawn, and the seat will be offered to the next candidate on merit immediately.

Applicants will have to bear their own traveling expenses. All admissions to M.Sc. Nursing course are provisional, subject to the approval and confirmation of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

M.SC. NURSING ADMISSION 2025 – FEE DETAILS

Hostel if desired will be provided at Rs.30,000/- per year (only for female students).

Additional University Fee (Registration, Examination & others) will be paid by the applicant as may be decided by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot. Fee for the subsequent year will be notified later.

At the time of reporting for counseling, the candidate has to deposit the fee either as lump sum or six months fee and total hostel fee. This has to be in the form of Bank Demand Draft ONLY in favour of 'Christian Medical College Ludhiana Society', payable at Ludhiana. Balance 6 months fee has to be paid by 15th March 2026. Students with Service Obligation can apply for financial assistance if required. Please enquire at Registrar Office.

Note: Any student failing in any university professional M. Sc. Nursing Examination and or repeating the session will be charged college fees and residential fee for the additional period spent in the college & hostel as per rules.

Security Deposit is refundable if claimed within one year of leaving the College after getting clearance as per rules.

The Management reserves the right to revise the college fees, hostel fees and any other fees from time to time and these will be effective from the dates asmay be decided.

REFUND RULES

Generally, no refund of fee is permitted on account of withdrawal/absence from college or other reasons once a student is admitted to any course of study. A refund claim may, however, be admitted on merits after due consideration of the request by the institution.

- 1. Any time after admission upto the last date by University/ INC, full fee will be refunded, after deducting the admission fee and any expenses incurred by the institution towards the candidate.
- 2. On the last date of admission, full fee except the admission fee and any other expenses incurred by the institution towards the candidate, will be refunded, provided the seat is filled. In the event the seat in question remains vacant, the candidate will be required to pay the fees for the entire duration of the course.
- 3. No candidate will be allowed to take their original certificates for any reason. If for some purpose the applicant insists on taking the original certificates for a period, they need to pay the remaining year's tuition fees in advance.

SECURITY DEPOSIT of Rs. 5000/- is refundable only after the completion of the course.

All refunds will be processed by the Finance Officer based on the recommendation from the Registrar & Principal. A refund will be made after the candidate has surrendered the original fee receipt and the dues clearance certificate.

FILLING UP OF VACANT SEATS

Vacant seats (if any) arising will be displayed periodically on our website **www.cmcludhiana.in** and on the notice board of the office of the registrar. <u>There will</u> not be any individual communication to any candidate regarding the status of any vacant seats.

The second counseling (if required) will be held notified later. In the event any seats fall vacant after this date, such seats will be filled later on according to the last date of MSc. Nursing admission.

All candidates who have cleared the CMC-M.Sc. Entrance Examination-2025 (including those who have already taken admission in College of Nursing and those who were absent in the previous counseling) will be eligible for the vacant seats arising.

A candidate desirous of participating in a subsequent counseling after already having taken admission in any M.Sc. course shall first have to vacate the present course seat (as per rules) and let that seat be put up for counseling too.

Vacant seats arising during the counseling due to shifting of courses from already admitted candidates will be announced immediately and will be offered to the next meritorious candidate onwards.

An applicant once admitted to M.Sc. Nursing course shall not leave the college unless a bonafide replacement is available within the prescribed time period permitted for regular and late admission by the university with which this college is affiliated. An applicant wishing to leave the college keeping a seat vacant with no replacement shall have to pay the college fees of the remaining years.

SECURITY DEPOSIT is refundable only after the completion of the course.

In all cases where the student has been admitted to the course after the commencement of classes through the waiting list or otherwise, the number of days specified in 1 & 2 above will be reckoned from the date of "commencement of classes" and not from the date of their actual admission.

Any student who withdraws from the course after fifteen days from the date of commencement of classes as mentioned in para 3 above will be required to remit to the institution in addition to the amount already forfeited, the tuition fee payable for the remaining period of the course.

All refunds will be processed by the Finance Officer based on the recommendation from the Registrar & Principal. Refund will be made after the candidate has surrendered the original fee receipt and the dues clearance certificate.

UNIFORM

Those who are admitted to the College of Nursing should bring the following :

Women : Black pants with White Shirt, Black Cardigan, White overall and Black Shoes.

Gents : Black Pants, White Shirt, Black V-Neck Sweater, White overall and Black Shoes.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Medical examination of the newly admitted provisional students will be notified later. <u>ANY</u> <u>APPLICANT FOUND MEDICALLY UNFIT WILL NOT BE</u> <u>ALLOWED TO</u> <u>CONTINUE</u> <u>HIS/HER STUDIES IN THE COLLEGE.</u>

CLASSES

Classes starting date will be notified later. Students must be regular in attending classes to facilitate their admission to be approved and confirmed by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, Punjab with which this college is affiliated. If a student is found to be remaining absent continuously for 7 days from classes or clinical area without permission from the Principal of the College of Nursing, it will be considered that the student is not willing to continue studies in this college. In that case, admission of student may be cancelled.

REJECTION AND DISQUALIFICATION

An application will be rejected if :

- 1. Application form duly filled in along with necessary enclosures which is not received on or before 5:00 pm, 20.06.2025.
- 2. Application form incompletely/wrongly filled in.
- 3. Certificates and testimonials found to be inaccurate or false.
- 4. Failing to take the Admission Written Test.
- 5. Failing to be present for scrutiny of certificates and testimonials etc.
- 6. Failing to submit the college and other fees by the due date.
- 7. Educational and other requirements of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Indian Nursing Council as may be applicable, and of College of Nursing, Christian Medical College, Ludhiana are not fulfilled.

It is to be clearly understood that submission of complete application for admission does not in itself confer a right to be called for admission written test or to be called to Ludhiana for checking of original certificates or admission to the college, and that the choice of applicants for selection and admission rests with the Selection Committee of the institution.

Any attempt by applicants or their friends or relatives, to canvas for admission or to bring influence to bear upon the administrative and/or other staff members shall render the applicants disgualified.

The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final and no correspondence will be entertained regarding the rejection or disqualification of any candidate.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR M. Sc. NURSING STUDENTS

- 1. The students are instructed to join as per the University rules. Students joining late must make up for lost classes.
- 2. Students are expected to have an attendance of at least 80% in classes and clinical areas in each subject for appearing for examination.
- 3. A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the Practical areas before awarding of degree.
- The students are not allowed any kind of leave during the course except vacation and sickness as per the University Calendar unless the reasons for taking leave are justified by the college authorities.
- 5. Vacation is granted by the college as per regulations of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences and students are not allowed to extend the leave on any ground.
- Sick Leave (permitted by College Authority) excess of 10 days in each year must be made up. Sick leaves must be accompanied by medical certificate from SSHS or Civil surgeon if out of Ludhiana or from Medical Supdt. of Mission Hospital.
- 7. All make up days will be completed before proceeding for vacation or before completion of the course.
- 8. Students must report at 8.00 a.m. in the College of Nursing.
- 9. Students will observe the hostel timings.
- 10. In case of sickness, students will report to the office of the principal.
- 11. In case a lady student wants to avail leave due to maternity, her course of study will be prolonged by six months.

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION

The date of receipt of examination admission form will be fixed by the Syndicate of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences.

ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

The Association is a channel for interchange of experience and ideas in nursing service/administration/education and research. The Life Membership Fee is Rs. 5000.00 (Rupees Five Thousand only). Alumni organize scientific sessions & celebrates initiation ceremony of new graduates. Members are invited for the same and the association honors members who have completed 25 years of service. Newsletters are sent to the members from time to time.

STAFF AND STUDENTS' HEALTH SERVICE

This service was initiated with the intention of bringing the medical care and supervision of staff, medical students, paramedical students, and student nurses under one doctor. A central clinic is available in the hospital out - patient area. Routine examinations, including X-ray screening are carried out on all newcomers and immunization against various diseases is available. There is a ward unit allocated for those who need admission to hospital. A student who has to undergo cosmetic & elective surgery should get it done during his/her vacation period and charges for the same will be as per the institutional rules. Attention is also given to physical fitness, environmental hygiene, mental health and the prevention of tuberculosis. The general aim is to control and diminish the incidence of sickness and keep the students physically and mentally fit to face their life and study.

STUDENT ACTIVITIES

A wide variety of activities are encouraged at all levels for the Student Nurses Association members. The diversity of activities is derived from the professional, social, cultural and recreational spheres. The activities are geared to strengthen extra-curricular components.

A three to four days conference is held for Student Nurses Association members biennially. It provides a forum for the members to discuss and find solutions for various problems faced by the students. Student Nurses Association (SNA) organizes competitions i.e., project work, exhibitions, public speaking & writing, dances, music, painting, and sports & games etc. at state and national level. Awards and prizes are given to the winners.

Library

The College of Nursing library consists of 6272 books and journals of nursing practice, basic and clinical sciences. It also has other general and recreational books. The Library subscribes to 17 journals, both National and International, in addition to Text Books.

The Library service is available to the users for 11 hours (8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.) for female students and 09 hours (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.) for male students from Monday to Friday and 5 hours (8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.) on Saturday.

In addition, there is a Christian Medical College library adjacent to M.C. Hostel. There is a Panjab University Extension Library also available at Ludhiana for staff and students.

- 1. In University examination, minimum pass marks shall be 50% in each of the Theory and Practical papers separately.
- 2. A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in Theory and Practical in each subject appearing for the examination.

- 6. Maximum number of attempts permitted for each paper is 3, including the first attempt.
- The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 4 (four) years.
- 8. A candidate failing in more than two subjects will not be promoted to the 2nd year.
- 9. No candidate shall be admitted to the subsequent 2nd year examination unless the candidate has passed the 1st year examination.
